NO. 22 CALIFORNIA GOLDEN BEARS (33-17, 17-10 Pac-12)



The No. 22 Golden Bears travel to the Pacific Northwest this week to conclude their regular season for a three game series against No. 23 Oregon State in Corvallis, Oregon. After winning two of three over No. 15 USC, the Bears have now won 10 of their last 13 games. The Beavers are 8-1-1 in their last 10 after posting a 4-0 week on the road last week, including a 20-0 whitewashing of Portland State, and a sweep of Stanford on the Farm. They fell on Tuesday at home to rival Oregon, 3-2 in extra innings.

Paul Named Pac-12 Player of the Week

The Pac-12 announced California senior first baseman as the conference's player of the week on Tuesday after his incredible performance this past week

in a series win over No. 15 USC. Paul capped the final regular season home series off in incredible fashion, going 3-for-3 with a pair of doubles and five RBI in the 7-2 win on Monday night. He batted an eye-popping 7-for-10 (.700) with three doubles and nine RBI. The senior also took home Muscle Milk Student-Athlete of the Week honors on CalBears.com.

Seniors Lead the Way on Senior Day

The Bears hosted Senior Day this past Sunday afternoon to honor the three graduating seniors, reliever Chris Muse-Fisher, closer Dylan Nelson and first baseman Chris Paul. All three played major roles in the 7-5 win over No. 15 USC, as Muse-Fisher logged 3.1 innings, striking out three and

allowing just one hit in relief. Paul went 2-for-4 with three RBI to lead the charge offensively. Nelson notched his team-high eighth save, pitching two spotless innings to secure the victory.

Martinez Impresses

Cal freshman right-hander Erik Martinez continued his fantastic season on Monday, picking up his second win of the year with 3.1 shutout innings of quality work out of the Bears' bullpen. He struck out five and allowed just one base hit against the No. 15 Trojans to improve to 2-1.

Martinez, a West Covina, California, native leads the Bears in ERA (1.50) and has been a key component of the Cal pitching staff, providing reliable relief out of the pen.

Fit to be Tied

California and No. 16 Arizona State are currently tied in third place in the Pac-12 standings at 17-10, both just a half game behind Cal's opponent this week,

No. 23 Oregon State, who sit alone in second place at 17-9-1. With a series win over the Beavers, the Golden Bears could potentially finish in second, which would be the program's highest finish since Bob Milano's 1985 squad tied for second place with a 17-13 record. Cal's best finish under head coach David Esquer came in 2001, when the Golden Bears finished in a tie for third with a 14-10 record.

Conference Wins

Cal's 17 wins in conference thus far in 2015 are the most ever in head coach David Esquer's 16-year tenure. His previous high came in 2001, when the Bears tallied 14. 2015's total is the program's highest since Bob Milano's 1995 team went 18-12 on their way to a third place finish.

Productive Pearson Performs

Junior outfielder Devin Pearson has been extremely productive over the course of the last four weeks dating back to an April 25 game against the Arizona Wildcats, hitting 22-44 (.500) with two home runs, nine RBI, 13 runs scored and has drawn five walks. He was 7-for-9 (.778) with one RBI and scored five times in Cal's series win over No. 15 USC this past weekend.

Iron Men

Four members of the Golden Bears have appeared and started all 50 games in 2015. Sophomore third baseman Lucas Erceg, sophomore center fielder Aaron Knapp, freshman shortstop Preston Grand Pre and freshman catcher Brett Cumberland have been constant fixtures in head coach David Esquer's lineup.

Pitching In

Cal Pitching Coach Mike Neu's staff has been very impressive thus far in 2015, as the group has compiled an earned run average of 3.03, which ranks them third in the Pac-12, just behind their opponent this week, Oregon State (2.97). As a whole, the staff has recorded 311 strikeouts in 443.0 innings of work.

Arms Race

A quartet of Bears have certainly stood out on the mound in 2015. Sophomore

left-hander Daulton Jefferies is 5-4 with a 3.17 ERA and 62 strikeouts in just 65.1 innings pitched. Freshman righty Jeff Bain is 6-2 on the campaign with a 2.29 ERA (sixth in the Pac-12) and has tallied 29 strikeouts in just 59.0 innings, holding opponents to a .202 batting average (third best in the conference). Junior right-hander Ryan Mason has also been fantastic thus far, posting a 6-2 record with a 3.19 ERA with 33 k's in 84.2 (tied for ninth in the Pac-12) innings. Freshman lefty Matt Ladrech has logged 77.2 innings and has compiled a 6-4 record with a stingy 2.67 ERA (10th best in the conference).

Closing Time

Five different Golden Bears have registered saves out of Cal's bullpen in 2015. Senior closer Dylan Nelson leads the team with eight saves, and has posted a 3.60 ERA, striking out 31 in just 25.0 innings. Additionally, senior left-hander Chris Muse-Fisher has recorded a pair of saves and is 3-1 on the year, racking up 32 strikeouts in 33.1 innings. Freshman righty Erik Martinez, who leads the staff with a 1.50 ERA, sophomore Lucas Erceg and junior Collin Monsour have each earned one save apiece as well.

.300 Club

Four Bears are hitting over .300 thus far on the season (all of which have appeared in 31 or more games with at least 100 at-bats), led by junior outfielder Devin Pearson, who is batting .370 in 31 games played with four home runs and 21 RBI. Senior first baseman Chris Paul is hitting .335 with eight homers and 42 RBI, while sophomore third baseman Lucas Erceg is batting .310 with a team-high 10 home runs and 38 RBI. Sophomore center fielder Aaron Knapp is hitting at a .309 clip with 21 RBI as well.

CP6

Senior first baseman Chris Paul has been outstanding in his 47 appearances for the Golden Bears. He has notched a .335 batting average (ranking seventh in the Pac-12) with eight home runs and 42 RBI (tied for fifth in the Pac-12) and a .555 slugging percentage (ranking fifth in the conference) in 173 at-bats after

his breakout series against No. 15 USC this past weekend.

Excellent Erceg

Sophomore third baseman Lucas Erceg has a team-high 10 home runs and has driven in 38. He is tied for second in the Pac-12 in home runs and is tied for ninth in runs batted in.

Powerful Bears

The Bears lead the Pac-12 in home runs with 41. Sophomore third baseman Lucas Erceg leads the team with 10, while senior first baseman Chris Paul is right behind him with eight long balls.

Walk This Way

Freshman Brett Cumberland leads the Bears in walks with 32 thus far this season. The freshman's patient approach has certainly paid dividends for the Bears, and he ranks third in the Pac-12 in the category. Additionally, Cumberland has been hit by a team-high 14 pitches, which also ranks him third in the conference.

Esquer Among Nation's Best

Esquer, 49, is in his 16th season with a career record of 465-413-2 (.528). In 2011 he led the Bears to the program's first appearance at the College World Series since 1992, and was named the National Coach of the Year.




