Quick Hits

- ORU will continue play in the MGM Grand Main Event with Friday's contest at Oregon State. The Golden Eagles won their first game of the tournament, beating Tulsa in the season opener. Following Friday's contest, all seven teams in the tournament will head to Las Vegas to finish the tournament in the MGM Grand Garden Arena.
- **A win Friday would** be ORU's first victory over a current member of the Pac-12 since beating Utah 78-70 November 27, 2010. ORU is 7-14 all-time against current members of the Pac-12, including winning records against USC (4-3), Stanford (1-0) and Utah (1-0).
- **A loss Friday would** give OSU a 2-1 lead in the all-time series against Oregon State. ORU beat the Beavers in 1976 as part of the Far West Classic in Portland, Ore., while OSU won 112-87 in 1991.
- ORU opened the season with a 77-68 victory over Tulsa in the annual PSO Mayor's Cup. ORU has now won back-to-back PSO Mayor's Cup games over the Golden Hurricane, winning 74-68 at the Reynolds Center last year.

2013-14 Review

In 2013-14, ORU started out hot, winning the PSO Mayor's Cup with a victory over Tulsa and went on to win the Mayan Division of the 2013 Cancun Challenge. A tough stretch in the middle of the year saddled ORU with four straight losses, with three coming by a combined eight points, and the Golden Eagles finished conference play 10-8 in a tie for 5th place.

About ORU

Founded in 1963 by evangelist Oral Roberts, ORU is a 400-acre campus located in South Tulsa. ORU boasts a total enrollment of over 5,000 students from all 50 states and more than 30 foreign countries. Some famous ORU alums include entertainer Kathy Lee Gifford, Pulitzer-prize nominated author Clifton Taulbert and two-time NCAA track & field national champion and 2008 Olympic silver medalist Andretti Bain, 2012 NCAA outdoor national champion Jack Whitt and 2012 Olympians Prince Mumba (Track) and Dominique Allen (Women's Basketball). "The Simpsons" creator Matt Groening briefly attended ORU, and subsequently, many of the characters on the show are modeled after former ORU students and staff members. In fact, if you look closely over Ned Flanders' fireplace, his college diploma reads "Oral Roberts University".

About the Summit League

In its fourth decade of Division I athletics, The Summit League offers 19 championship sports and has a combined enrollment of over 120,000 at nine institutions, including four located in top 60 U.S. metro populations and two land-grant universities. Member institutions include: Denver (University of Denver), Fort Wayne (Indiana University-Purdue University-Fort Wayne), IUPUI (Indiana University-Purdue University-Indianapolis), North Dakota State University, Omaha (University of Nebraska Omaha), Oral Roberts University, the University of South Dakota, South Dakota State University and Western Illinois University. Previously known as the Mid-Continent Conference, The Summit League rebranded in 2007 and has since produced eight NCAA Champions, and over 85 All-Americans and 63 Academic All-America selections.

Since its inception in 1982, The Summit League recorded several transcendent moments that resonate on the national stage. While known as the Mid-Continent Conference, the league's first two decades produced a pair of appearances in the NCAA Men's Basketball Tournament's "Sweet 16" and the Women's College World Series as well as three individual NCAA Track and Field Champions.

To coincide with The Summit League's 30th Anniversary Season in 2011-12, the league released a list of its Top 30 Distinguished Contributors from the Division I era as selected by a panel of voters from member schools and the media. Four individual NCAA champions and three Olympic medalists, along with four NBA players and two World Series Champions headlined The Summit League's list of top student-athletes, coaches and administrators that was the jewel of the anniversary celebration. Included on the list where ORU alumni Andretti Bain, Dennis Bigley, Caleb Green, Prince Mumba, Krista Ragan, Jack Whitt and Ori Zuzic.

All ORU games can be heard in northeastern Oklahoma on "The Sports Animal," 91.7FM and 1550 AM. Geoff Haxton begins his eighth full season as the play-by-play voice of the Golden Eagles. Fans can also listen online at www.ORUAthletics.com. The pregame show begins 15 minutes prior to tip-off.
