vs. UTAH: Oregon State and Utah meet for the 27th time in history with the Utes leading the series 16-10. The home team has dominated the series with the Beavers holding a 9-2 advantage in Corvallis and Utah owning a 12-1 clip in games played in Salt Lake City. The Utes own a pair of neutral site victories, including a 70-64 win on March 12, 1966 in the NCAA Tournament West Regional Final in Los Angeles and a 69-61 win on Dec. 20, 1997 at the Rose Garden in Portland when Utah was ranked seventh in the nation.

Since becoming a member of the Pac-12 in 2012, Utah leads the series, 4-3, with Oregon State winning the first three games and the Utes taking the last four.

Utah won the first meeting between the teams this season, 59-53, on Jan. 17 in Salt Lake City. The Beavers built a 14-point first-half lead, before the Utes rallied for the win. Gary Payton II and Tres Tinkle led Oregon State with 11 points apiece.

The teams played a defensive battle in their lone meeting last season with Utah winning 47-37. It ended a 14-0 start at Gill Coliseum for Oregon State.

A WIN OVER THE UTES: If Oregon State defeats Utah it will improve to 13-8 overall and 4-6 in Pac-12 play. It would also:

- Give Oregon State the opportunity to sweep the Mountain schools at home for the first time since 2012.
- Snap a four-game losing streak to Utah.
- Be the second consecutive Pac-12 home win for Oregon State.

TEAM NOTES: Here are some quick-hitters about the 2015-16 Oregon State men's basketball team:

- In Pac-12 home games, Oregon State is averaging 75.4 points, while shooting 45.0 percent from the field and 29.1 percent from beyond the arc. Pac-12 opponents at Gill Coliseum are averaging 71.6 points, while shooting 43.1 percent from the field and 32.4 percent from beyond the arc.
- In Pac-12 road games, the Beavers are averaging 59.5 points, while shooting 38.4 percent from the field and 36.0 percent from deep. Pac-12 opponents on their home court are averaging 74.0 points, while shooting 50.3 percent from the field and 38.3 percent from deep.
- Oregon State has fewer turnovers than its opponent in all nine Pac-12 games. Its turnover margin of +4.1 in conference games is second in the Pac-12.
- The Beavers are 9-0 (3-0 Pac-12) with more or equal rebounds as their opponent, and 3-8 (0-6 Pac-12) when the opposition has more boards. Oregon State's rebounding margin of -7.2 in conference games is last in the Pac-12.
- The Beavers had season lows for rebounds (24) and blocked shots (0) at both Arizona State and Arizona last week.
- Oregon State is outscoring its opponent in all five specialty statistics: 301-239 on points off turnovers, 220-214 on second chance points, 644-546 in the paint, 154-100 on fast break points and 542-384 in bench scoring.
- The Beavers have scored at least 70 points in 13 of their 20 games. They hit the 70-point mark in seven of their 31 games last season.
- Since Wayne Tinkle took over, Oregon State is 23-5 (10-2 this season) when leading at halftime, 26-2 (12-1 this season) when leading with five minutes to play and 16-1 (6-0 this season) when outrebounding its opponent.
- Oregon State defeated No. 7 Arizona, 58-56, last season and No. 21 USC, 85-70, this season. It's the first time the Beavers have wins over Top 25 teams in back-to-back seasons since 2005-2006.
- Oregon State won nine non-conference games for the second straight season under Wayne Tinkle (9-3 in 2014-15, 9-2 in 2015-16).

GARY PAYTON II: Here are some quick hitters about Gary Payton II, a senior from Seattle, Wash.:

- Leads the team in scoring, rebounding, assists and steals. Lester Conner (1981-82) is the only Beaver to lead the team in all four categories.
- Named All-Pac-12 First Team, Pac-12 All-Defensive Team and Pac-12 Defensive Player of the Year last season. A look at his stats the last two years:

- Is the only player in the Pac-12 in the top 10 in scoring (16.3, seventh), rebounding (8.1, eighth), assists (5.5, second) and steals (2.3, first).
- Scored in double figures in 17 of the first 18 games but failed to reach double digits the last two games. He has never gone three consecutive games without hitting double figures in his Oregon State career.
- In Pac-12 conference games, he's first in assists (6.0), and second in steals (2.0) and assist/turnover ratio (2.7).
- In Pac-12 home games, he's averaging 18.6 points, 8.8 rebounds, 7.0 assists and 2.4 steals. In Pac-12 road games, he's averaging 12.0 points, 6.8 rebounds, 4.8 assists and 1.5 steals.
- Set the Oregon State record for consecutive games with a steal (38), breaking his father's record.
- He's the only Pac-12 player named one of 10 finalists for the Bob Cousy Award and the USBWA Midseason Watch List. He was one of three Pac-12 players selected to the John R. Wooden Midseason Top 25.

DANIEL GOMIS: Here are some quick hitters about Daniel Gomis, a senior forward from Thies, Senegal:

- Had his best game of the season with two points and four rebounds in 24 minutes before fouling out at Arizona. His previous season high was 10 minutes in the Pac-12 opener against Oregon.
- Has played in 10 of the past 11 games after missing the first nine with an injury.
- Is tied for ninth with Jose Ortiz (1986-87) on Oregon State's career blocked shots list with 73.

LANGSTON MORRIS-WALKER: Here are some quick hitters about Langston Morris-Walker, a senior guard from Berkeley, California:

- Has scored in double figures five times and five points or less 10 times.
- Has come off the bench the past four games; averaging 6.5 points and 2.0 rebounds as a reserve after averaging 5.9 points and 3.2 boards as a starter.
- Shooting 38.0 percent (19-for-50) from beyond the arc. It's the second-best percentage on the team, trailing only Derrick Bruce who has taken 11 shots from deep (6-for-11). Morris-Walker entered the season a career 32.3 percent from beyond the arc (65-for-201).
- Made multiple 3-pointers in seven games, one from deep in four games and none in the other nine games.
- Shot a team-best 34.3 percent (24-for-70) from beyond the arc in Pac-12 games last season. He's shooting 35.0 percent (7-for-20) in conference games this season, which is second on the team (Tres Tinkle, 40.6 percent).

JARMAL REID: Here are some quick hitters about Jarmal Reid, a senior forward from Decatur, Georgia:

- Was suspended a minimum of four games on Monday, Jan. 18 for committing a flagrant 2 foul in the final minutes at Utah. It's the first time he has been suspended in his four years at Oregon State.
- Missed the first six games this season with a stress fracture in his right foot and the Civil War with a sprained ankle.
- Has struggled from the field (.353) but shooting well at the stripe (.737).
- Shot 73.8 percent (79-107) from the free throw line last season; he was a 44.7 percent (17-for-38) shooter from the stripe his first two years.

OLAF SCHAFTEAAR: Here are some quick hitters about Olaf Schaftenaar, a senior forward from Utrecht, Netherlands:

- Leads team with an assist/turnover ratio of 2.20 (33 assists, 15 turnovers) and free throw percentage (.789).
- Made a 3-pointer in a career-best 13 consecutive games earlier this season.
- Tied a career high with four 3-pointers at Arizona (4-for-8).
- In the five games before Arizona, he was 1-for-11 from beyond the arc.
- In the nine games before that, he was 15-for-29 (.517) from deep.
- On the season, he's shooting 45.0 percent (18-for-40) inside the arc and 36.9 percent (24-for-65) outside the arc.
- In his first two seasons, 136 of his 167 shots were 3-pointers (81.4%); last season 125 of his 204 shots were from deep (61.3%).
- This season 65 of his 105 shots have been from beyond the arc (61.9%).

MALCOLM DUVIVIER: Here are some quick hitters about Malcolm Duvivier, a junior guard from Toronto, Canada:

- Went 0-for-4 at Arizona; it was his third scoreless game of the season.
- In four games before Arizona, he was 12-for-27 (.444) from the field and 4-for-10 (.400) from beyond the arc, while averaging 7.8 points per game.
- In the six games before that, he was 3-for-23 (.130) from the field and 1-for-11 (.091) from deep, while averaging 2.7 points per game.
- On the season, he's shooting 40.0 percent (24-for-60) inside the arc and 35.8 percent (19-for-53) outside the arc.
- Entering this season he was 37.0 percent (110-of-297) from the field and 34.4 percent (44-for-128) from beyond the arc.
- Went 5-for-13 (.385) from the free throw line the first eight games, 14-for-17 (.824) the next eight games and 3-for-7 since.
- Has career highs this season with 3-pointers made (4 at Rice) and assists (6 vs. Northwest Christian and at UC Santa Barbara).

CHEIKH N'DIAYE: Here are some quick hitters about Cheikh N'diaye, a junior center from Dakar, Senegal:

- Has played one minute the past three games; didn't play against USC or at Arizona.
- Is 7-for-8 (.875) from the field this season; he led the team at 62.5 percent (20-for-32) last season.
- Made five field goals in the last four games he played, including a 2-for-2 performance against both California and UCLA. He made a total of two field goals in the first nine games he played.
- Missed a month of practice before the season started with a shoulder injury.

DERRICK BRUCE: Here are some quick hitters about Derrick Bruce, a freshman guard from Moreno Valley, Calif.:

- Tied a career-high with eight points against Arizona State. He's scored a total of four points in his other five Pac-12 games.
- Went 2-for-3 from deep and 2-for-2 from the stripe at Arizona State.
- Has an assist/turnover ratio of 1.60 (16 assists, 10 turnovers).
- Is 6-for-11 (.545) from the 3-point line and 4-for-24 (.167) inside the arc.

DREW EUBANKS: Here are some quick hitters about Drew Eubanks, a freshman forward from Troutdale, Ore.:

- Started the first 15 games, came off the bench the next two and returned to the starting lineup the past three games.
- Averaging 8.2 points and 4.1 rebounds in 21.3 minutes as a starter. Averaged 5.0 points and 5.5 rebounds in 19.0 minutes as a reserve.
- Shot 66.1 percent (37-of-56) in the 11 non-conference games and is shooting 50.0 percent (28-for-56) in the nine Pac-12 games.
- Is fifth in the Pac-12 in field goal percentage at 58.0 percent (65-for-112).
- Leads the team in blocks (25); his average of 1.3 is 12th in the Pac-12.
- Had five blocks against Valparaiso, the most ever by an Oregon State true freshman in a game.
- Became the first Oregon State true freshman to start a season opener since Seth Tarver in 2006.

GLIGORIJE RAKOCEVIC: Here are some quick hitters about Gligorije Rakocevic, a freshman center from Bijelo Polje, Montenegro:

- Had eight points and seven rebounds in 20 minutes in the last homestand against the L.A. schools. Didn't record a point or rebound in nine minutes on the Arizona trip.
- Had career highs with five rebounds and 14 minutes against USC.
- Went 2-for-3 against UCLA on Jan. 20, his first made field goal since Dec. 2 against Loyola Marymount.
- Suffered a concussion in practice and had to sit out the Cal State Fullerton, Tulsa and Quinnipiac games.

STEPHEN THOMPSON JR.: Here are some quick hitters about Stephen Thompson Jr., a freshman guard from Los Angeles, Calif.:

- Has made at least one 3-pointer in a team-high 16 games, including two separate streaks of seven consecutive games.
- Has scored in double figures in 12 games (third on the team).
- Third on the team in scoring (9.8) despite being seventh in average minutes played (19.5).
- On pace for 44 3-pointers in a minimum of 30 games; the Oregon State freshman record is 45 by Angelo Tsagarakis in 2003-04.
- Became the first Oregon State freshman to make at least four 3-pointers in his college debut.

TRES TINKLE: Here are some quick hitters about Tres Tinkle, a freshman forward from Missoula, Mont.:

- In four games as a starter, he's averaging a team-high 15.3 points and 5.5 rebounds (second on the team).
- In the past seven games, he's 13-for-27 (.481) from beyond the arc. In the four games before that, he was 0-for-7 from deep.
- Among Pac-12 freshmen, he's fifth in scoring (12.4), sixth in rebounding (5.1), third in free throw percentage (.743), fifth in 3-point percentage (.379), third in steals (1.3) and 10th in assists (1.1).
- Is ninth in the Pac-12 in steals (1.3); has at least one steal in 18 of the 20 games.
- Leads the team in 3-point field goal percentage (.385).
- In the first seven games, he shot 26.9 percent (14-for-52) from the field and 20.0 percent (3-for-15) from deep. In the 13 games since, he's 48.0 percent (60-for-125) from the field and 44.2 percent (19-for-43) from deep.

WAYNE TINKLE

Head Coach 2nd Year Montana, 2005

Wayne Tinkle delivered as promised in his first season as Oregon State's head basketball coach.

Assuming the helm of a team picked to finish last in the Pac-12 after losing its top five scorers from the previous season, Tinkle guided the Beavers to a 17-14 overall record, the most home wins (15) in school history, and victories over Pac-12 champion Arizona and NCAA Sweet-16 finisher UCLA.

The 49-year-old Tinkle, who came to Oregon State on May 19, 2014, after eight successful seasons at the University of Montana, became the fourth OSU coach since 1928 to record a winning record in his first season. He joined Beaver legends Slats Gill, Paul Valenti and Jim Anderson in that exclusive fraternity.

Tinkle's debut season was replete with accomplishments and highlight moments. The Beavers:

- Set a school record for their best start at Gill Coliseum (14-0) and the most home wins in a single season (15).
- Posted an 8-10 Pac-12 record, their best conference mark since the 1992-93 team finished 9-9.
- Defeated No. 7 Arizona for their first win over a top-10 team in 15 years.
- Defeated Arizona, UCLA and Washington in the same season for the first time since 1990.
- Also downed DePaul of the Big East and Mississippi State of the SEC.

Tinkle stressed defense from his first day on the job and the Beavers responded. They led the Pac-12 in steals, 3-point field goal percentage defense and turnover margin. They also set school records for scoring defense, field-goal percentage defense and 3-point field goal percentage defense.

Tinkle steadfastly preached the value of teamwork but the Beavers had their share of individual accomplishments as well.

Guard Gary Payton II was named the Pac-12 Defensive Player of the Year and earned All-Pac-12 First Team and Pac-12 All-Defensive Team honors after finishing second in the nation in steals. The junior transfer had a steal in all 31 games, the second-longest streak in school history. His 95 steals were the second most in Oregon State single-season history and tied for the third most in a season in Pac-12 history.

Tinkle inherited a senior-less program depleted by the graduation or transfer of six players who combined for 128 starts. That manpower shortage was further exacerbated in the offseason when Chi Baker, a touted incoming recruit from Florida who was expected to see significant playing time, was stricken with a heart ailment that sidelined him for the season.

Baker's illness left the Beavers with just eight scholarship players. However, Tinkle cleared that hurdle by holding a campus-wide open tryout just before the start of practice.

Five of the 22 participants were added to the official roster, joining two walk-ons from the previous season, and all played a major part in the team's success, as role players or by pushing the starters in practice. Tinkle subsequently rewarded them for their dedication and commitment by starting five walk-ons, all from the state of Oregon, against rival Oregon in the team's final regular-season home game.

The success of Tinkle's first season at Oregon State was noted nationally as he was named a semifinalist for the Naismith National Coach of the Year.

The future for Oregon State basketball looks bright, as Tinkle and his coaching staff signed five players for their 2015-16 recruiting class, which is ranked in the top 20 in the nation, the highest-ranking class in school history.

Tinkle was named the 21st head coach in OSU history on May 19, 2014, after leading Montana to three NCAA Tournament appearances and seven winning records in eight seasons.

His Grizzlies captured Big Sky Conference regular-season titles in 2010, 2012 and 2013, and Big Sky Conference Tournament championships in 2012 and 2013.

He led Montana to four consecutive postseason trips from 2010-13, including the NCAA Tournament in 2010, 2012 and 2013. His 97 conference wins are the most by any Montana coach and his 158 overall victories are the second-most in school history.

He was named the Big Sky Coach of the Year after the 2011-12 and 2012-13 seasons, and the NABC Division I All-District 6 Coach of the Year in 2012. He is the only coach in Montana history with three NCAA-Tournament berths and two Big Sky Coach of the Year awards.

Tinkle directed Montana to 25-7 seasons in 2011-12 and 2012-13 when the Grizzlies won the second-most games in school history in successive seasons. They won 25 consecutive Big Sky games in that span and set a conference record with 19 league wins in 2012-13.

Montana had winning records in seven of Tinkle's eight years as head coach and won 20 or more games in four consecutive seasons (2010-13). He also went to the NCAA tournament three times during his five years as an assistant coach under Don Holst, Pat Kennedy and Larry Krystkowiak, presently the head coach at the University of Utah.

The son of a college administrator, Tinkle was born on Jan. 26, 1966 in Milwaukee, Wis., as the youngest of 11 children (seven girls and four boys). He graduated from Ferris High School in Spokane, Wash., in 1984, and then enrolled at Montana, where he had a standout career from 1986-89.

Tinkle was a standout forward for the Grizzlies from 1986-89 and a three-time All-Big Sky pick his sophomore, junior and senior seasons. He ranks fourth all-time at Montana in rebounds (836), and sixth in points (1,500). He earned the team's Carl Dragstedt Award (MVP) in 1988 and 1989; led the team in rebounding in 1987, 1988 and 1989, and led the team in scoring in 1988 and 1989.

He then played professionally for 12 years with stints in the CBA and in Sweden, Spain, Italy and Greece before retiring to become a coach.

Tinkle earned his bachelor's degree from the University of Montana in health and human performance in 2005.

Tinkle is married to the former Lisa McLeod, who was a standout basketball player at Montana and was inducted into the Grizzly Sports Hall of Fame in 2011. They have two daughters, Joslyn and Elle, and one son, Tres.

Joslyn played in three basketball Final Fours during her four-year career at Stanford. Elle just finished her junior basketball season at Gonzaga and helped lead the Bulldogs to the Sweet 16.

A two-time Gatorade Montana Player of the Year at Missoula's Hellgate High School, Tres signed a National Letter of Intent with the Beavers in November 2014, and joined the program for the 2015-16 season.
