**LOS ANGELES** — The No. 10 Trojans (29-10, 10-5 Pac-12) will head out on the road for a tough Pac-12 series at Oregon State (25-12, 8-7 Pac-12), starting on Friday, April 24. The Trojans have won three of their last four contests and have won four of five Pac-12 weekend series.

The Trojans did not have a midweek contest this week, but come off a series win over Oregon last weekend at Dedeaux Field. The Trojans took two-of-three by winning game one and game three. **Mitch Hart** had a strong start on Sunday, holding the Ducks to just three hits and one run (solo home run) in six innings, while striking out a career-high eight batters. **Timmy Robinson** drove in seven runs over the team's four games last week, while **Bobby Stahel** extended his team and career high hitting streak to 21.

## Dedeaux Field

You knew there had to be something special about Dedeaux Field from the day it first opened its gates on March 30, 1974.

Righthander Russ McQueen threw a no-hitter that afternoon in the first game ever played at Dedeaux Field as USC swept a doubleheader from California. The Trojans went on to win the national championship that year and Dedeaux Field has been their home ever since.

The 2014 season marks the 40th season of play at Dedeaux Field.

One of the country's finest collegiate baseball structures, Dedeaux Field has continually been improved over recent years with the grandest project taking place before the 2002 season. A \$4 million project signified the largest improvement made to the facility as a new clubhouse and players' lounge were added on the first base side. Expanded offices for the coaching staff and new Hall of Fame were also part of the project, along with a new restroom pavilion.

A new bleacher section was added on the first base side, pushing capacity to 2,500 at Dedeaux Field.

The 2008 season brought a new scoreboard, along with the million-dollar Rod Dedeaux Research for Baseball Institute (RDRBI) which adds batting cages, a new weight room and state-of-the-art video motion analysis.

Prior to the 2011 season, a \$600,000 project added new lights to Dedeaux Field to bring the facility to NCAA-mandated standards for hosting postseason play.

With dimensions of 335 feet down the right and left field lines, 365 in the right field power alleys and 375 to the left field power alleys, and 395 to straightaway center, Dedeaux Field is a natural grass field.

Dedeaux Field has also been used extensively by the entertainment industry. It has been the site of MTV's "Rock-and-Jock" softball game and was used in the production and filming of several motion pictures, including "Mr. Baseball," "The Big Leager," "A League of Their Own" and "For Love of the Game."

**OREGON STATE-** The Beavers enter the series having won 2-of-3 over visiting Arizona last weekend. Much like the Trojans, the Beavers won games one and three en route to the series victory. The team is 25-12 overall and 8-7 in conference play.

The Trojans are 50-26 overall vs. the Beavers have won two-of-the last three as they took the series from the then-No. 1 team in the country to close out the 2014 season. The Trojans won on Friday 4-2, dropped the Saturday game 2-0 and then won the regular season finale 3-1 behind a gutty performance from current junior **Kyle Davis**, who threw a complete game in his first start of the year and only second of his career after getting the save on Friday. He tossed a career-high 17 strikeouts in the win.

The last time the Trojans played in Corvallis was in 2013, when they were swept, but in 2011 the Trojans took two-of-three at Goss Stadium, dropping game one before winning games two and three to take the series. The also took two-of-three in 2009 and are 4-5 in their last nine meetings at Goss Stadium.

**GOLDEN SPIKES -** **Bobby Stahel** and **Garrett Stubbs** were added to the 60-player midseason watch list for the prestigious Golden Spikes Award, given to the top amateur baseball athlete in the nation by USA Baseball. The honor is the first of each's career and they are the first Trojans since Ricky Oropesa was named to the preseason watch list in 2011. Catcher Jeff Clement was named a finalist for the award in 2005 and Mark Prior won it in 2001.

**DODGER STADIUM COLLEGE BASEBALL CLASSIC-** It does not appear like any team has ever defeated three different top-10 ranked opponents on consecutive days like the Trojans took care of business against No. 7 TCU, No. 1 Vanderbilt and No. 6 UCLA in the Dodger Stadium College Baseball Classic.

**RANKINGS** - The Trojans are ranked as high as No. 8 in the NCBWA rankings. In Baseball America and the D1baseball.com rankings, the Trojans are No. 10. The Trojans are also ranked 11th by Collegiate Baseball. The Trojans haven't been ranked this high since 2003.

**FASTEAST TO 25 WINS** - The Trojans reached the 25-win mark in 31 games, the fastest since they completed the same feat in 1998, the last year they won the College World Series. The Trojans are just two wins away from hitting their entire win total from last season.

**HITTING LAST YEAR'S TOTAL** - Last season in the Trojans had their first winning season since 2005, and they have already tied their win total from last season at 29-10. Last year they finished 29-24 and were one of the last four teams left out of the NCAA Tournament.

**STEALING BASES** - The Trojans stole 11 bases vs. Towson on Feb. 15, marking the second-most bases stolen in single game in Trojan history. The record is 12, set in 1995 vs. Arizona. Through the first 32 games, the Trojans have stolen 65-of-85 bases on the season. In 2014, they stole a total of 39 bases.

**IN THE NATIONAL STATS** - The Trojans rank in many national categories. **Bobby Stahel** is ninth in the nation with a .414 batting average. As a team their batting average of .298 ranks 36th nationally. The Trojans are averaging 1.67 stolen bases per game, 27th-best in the nation. The team's ERA of 3.00 ranks 25th nationally.

**HITTING STREAK -** **Bobby Stahel's** 21-game hitting streak is the longest since James Roberts had a streak of 21 games in 2012. The program high is 28, set by Jacque Jones in 1995.

**MAJOR LEAGUERS** - The Trojans had four major leaguers on rosters to start the season - Pitcher Ian Kennedy (Padres), Pitcher J.P. Howell (Dodgers), 1B Lucas Duda (Mets), Pitcher Brad Boxberger (Rays) and Pitcher Tommy Milone (Twins). Brent Strom is the pitching coach for the Houston Astros and Mark McGwire is the hitting coach for the Dodgers.

**HOT START** - The Trojans started the season 12-0 start, their fastest start since 1988, when they started 15-0.

**IN THE PAC-12 -** **Bobby Stahel** ranks second in the conference with a .414 batting average. Stahel's 65 hits also rank second. **Garrett Stubbs'** 17 stolen bases lead the conference. **Timmy Robinson** ranks tied for fourth with 31 RBI. The team ranks third with a .299 batting average, compared to Oregon State's .282 batting average, ranks fifth in the conference. USC's 3.00 ERA is the third-lowest in the conference, while Oregon State's 3.06 ERA ranks fifth.

**WEEKLY HONORS** — **Mitch Hart** threw the first two-hitter since 2009 in his first



## Dan Hubbs

**Head Coach**  
**3rd year**  
**4th year at USC**

Dan Hubbs is in his third season as head coach at Troy, after spending one season as associate head coach in 2012. He becomes only the sixth head coach at USC since 1930. Prior to that, he spent 12 seasons as pitching coach at California.

Hubbs was a 3-year (1991-93) letterman at USC. He currently is fourth on the Trojans' career saves list (22) and eighth on the career strikeouts per inning chart (9.19). He posted a career record of 19-13 with a 3.58 ERA in 81 appearances (64 in relief).

In his 12-year (2000-11) tenure at Cal, the 42-year-old Hubbs regularly produced team ERAs among the lowest in the Pac-10. Three times, his pitching staff set a school record for season strikeouts, including 475 in 2011 when the Golden Bears--a program that was slated to be discontinued after 2011 due to budget cuts but was saved through fundraising efforts--advanced to the College World Series for the first time since 1992. His 2011 staff was second in the Pac-10 with a 2.90 team ERA, posted 11 shutouts and at one point went 47 innings without allowing an earned run.

Besides being a top recruiter, he helped develop some of the greatest pitchers in Cal history, including current major leaguers Brandon Morrow, who became the school's highest draft pick ever (fifth in 2006), and Tyson Ross, Freshman All-Americans Kevin Miller (2008), Justin Jones (2010) and Kyle Porter (2011) and 2011 All-Pac-10 first teamer Erik Johnson. He produced Pac-10 save leaders in 2001 (Matt Brown) and 2004 (Jesse Ingram) and the school's career strikeout leader (Trevor Hutchinson). He had 4 pitchers drafted in 2011 and 3 in 2008, and saw 25 of his pitchers sign professional baseball contracts.

Before going to Cal, Hubbs was the pitching coach of the Yakima Bears (a short-season single A minor league Los Angeles Dodgers affiliate in Yakima, Wash.) and assisted Pepperdine during the 1999 season.

After seeing action in just 4 games as a 1990 freshman, he had a 7-2 record with a 3.60 ERA as a relief pitcher in 1991 as the Trojans won the Pac-10 title. He went 7-6 in 1992 with a 3.97 ERA as a starter. He returned to the bullpen in 1993, setting the since-broken USC season saves record (a national-best 18) while going 5-5 with a 2.96 ERA and a team-high 90 strikeouts as he earned All-American first team and All-Pac-10 first team honors. The Trojans advanced to the NCAA Regionals in 1990, 1991 and 1993.

Hubbs earned a bachelor's degree in finance from USC in 1993.

He had a seven-year (1993-99) minor league career with the Dodgers and Philadelphia Phillies. He finished second in the Dodgers' organization with 126 strikeouts in 1994. In 1996, he went a combined 16-1 between AAA Albuquerque (7-1) and La Romana (9-0) of the Dominican winter league, and was named to Baseball America's Winter League All-Star Team. He led the Pacific Coast League in appearances in 1997, taking the mound 62 times in a 144-game season. He finished his career with a 27-16 record with nine saves and a 3.75 ERA. In 427 innings, he struck out 436 while walking only 172.

He was born on Jan. 23, 1971. He and his wife, Alison, a USC graduate, have two sons, Patrick and Charlie.

career complete game as the Trojans defeated Washington State, 11-0.

**Dante Flores** had an outstanding week as the Trojans went 3-1, including a weekend sweep of the Dodger Stadium College Baseball Classic where they defeated No. 7 TCU 7-6 in 12-innings, No. 1 Vanderbilt 6-5 in nine innings and No. 6 UCLA 8-4 at Dodger Stadium to win Pac-12 Player of the Week and NCBWA Hitter of the Week honors. The honors are the first of his career. Overall on the week he went 7-for-16 (.438) with three runs scored, two doubles, one home run and three runs driven in. On Friday in the dramatic 12-inning, 7-6 walk-off victory vs. TCU, Flores went 3-for-3 with one run scored, one double and one sac bunt.

Then on Saturday vs. Vanderbilt, Flores went 1-for-4, with his one hit being a towering home run off the scoreboard in right field for his second home run of the day. The big home run in the fourth inning put the Trojans ahead 4-1, answering the Commodores' run in the top half of the inning.

Finally at Dodger Stadium on Sunday, the second baseman went 3-for-5 with one run scored and one RBI. Flores came through in the seventh inning with his second hit of the day, launching one off the top of the wall in right field, barely missing in a home run for a stand-up double. He drove in one run and came around to score as the Trojans broke open the game up to make the score 8-4.

**IN THE SOCIAL MEDIA WORLD** — Follow the Trojan baseball all year long on twitter, with the baseball specific twitter handle, **USC\_Baseball**. The Trojans are also on Instagram, with the handle **SCTrojans\_Baseball**.

**BALLPARK FUN** — For all Friday games, there will be free hot dogs for all USC students. On Sundays this season, there will be an autograph session available to all fans, starting 15 minutes after the game has been completed. Tuesday games will also be Taco Tuesdays.

**TROJANS ON THE NET** — USC baseball games this season will be broadcast live on [usctrojans.com](http://usctrojans.com) with video webcasts for majority of home games. For road games you can hear a live radio broadcast on [usctrojans.com](http://usctrojans.com).

**IN THE PAC-12** — The Trojans were picked to finish sixth in the Pac-12, an improvement from last season when they were selected ninth. They finished the 2014 campaign tied for fifth. UCLA is picked as the favorite, followed by Oregon, Arizona State, Stanford and Oregon State.

**RAKING IN THE ACCOLADES** — Junior catcher **Garrett Stubbs** was named a Preseason All-Pac-12 first team selection by College Sports Madness. The junior led the conference in runners caught attempting to steal in 2013. Freshman phenom **Jeremy Martinez** was also named Pac-12 Preseason Freshman of the Year by the publication.

**CLASS BY CLASS PROSPECTS** — Senior infielder **Dante Flores** was named the No. 44 senior in all of college baseball by Perfect Game USA. Likewise, junior left-handed pitcher **Kyle Twomey** was named the No. 55 junior and sophomore catcher/first baseman **Jeremy Martinez** was named the No. 28 sophomore. Finally, freshman right-handed pitcher **Mitch Hart** was named No. 9 in the freshman class nationally.

**TROJANS IN THE MAJORS** — In the history of the USC baseball program, a total of 109 players had made it to the major leagues. Current major leaguers include Ryan Cook (Oakland A's); Tommy Milone (Minnesota Twins); Brad Boxberger (Tampa Bay Rays); Grant Green (Los Angeles Angels of Anaheim); Lucas Duda (New York Mets); Ian Kennedy (San Diego Padres); JP Howell (Los Angeles Dodgers); Chad Smith (Oakland A's).

**COACHING THE TROOPS** — Volunteer assistant coach **Chris Duffy** comes to Troy from his alma mater South Mountain Community College, where he was an assistant coach for the past two seasons, assisting with the outfielders, hitters and base-running, while coaching first base and recruiting. He helped coach the team to the Division I Region Championship series for two-straight seasons, including winning the region in 2014. During his two years as a coach he had five outfielders receive NCAA Division I baseball scholarships. He was also an instrumental part of ensuring the success of the student-athletes in the classroom by monitoring academic progress and acting as a student-athlete success coach.

Duffy played 10 years of professional baseball, including four seasons as a major league outfielder after being drafted by the Pittsburgh Pirates in the eighth round of the 2001 MLB First Year Player's Draft. After having success as an all-star at virtually every level of the minor leagues, he was rated the best outfielder by Baseball America in 2004.
